XII. Pinzgauer World Congress in Austria in April 2018

The last Pinzgauer World Congress took place in Austria in 1998. 20 years later, we are once again host to Pinzgauer breeders from all over the world. The congress journey starts on Thursday, 19th April in Vienna and ends on Monday, 30th April in Salzburg. The main congress day is Thursday, 26th April in Goldegg Castle (Salzburg). The highlight is the Pinzgauer Cattle Show on Sunday, 29th April in Maishofen. There, single and dual-purpose Pinzgauer cattle from several European countries will be presented to the interested audience.

PROGRAMME



Day 1 – Thursday, 19th April 2018: VIENNA

Participants travel to Vienna. We will meet in the hotel for a welcome dinner.



Day 2 – Friday, 20th April 2018: VIENNA

We will visit the morning training at the Spanish Riding School, explore the city centre and visit Schönbrunn Palace. In the evening, there will be a classical concert.



Day 3 – Saturday, 21st April 2018: STYRIA

We will travel to Styria and learn about delicacies from the Riegersburg area: pumpkin seed oil, fruit and wine.



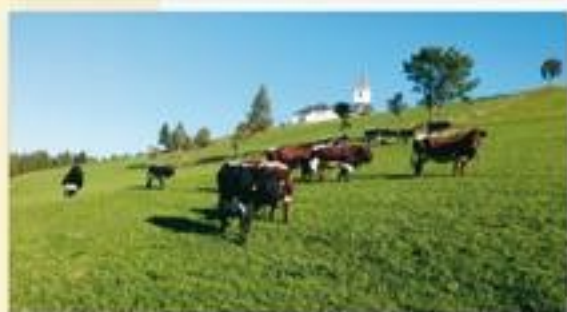
Day 4 – Sunday, 22nd April 2018: CARINTHIA

After a tour of the cattle marketing facilities in St. Donat, we will visit the farm of the Schnitzer family in Himmelberg, where Pinzgauer are bred for milk and suckler cow husbandry. Afterwards we will travel to Schlosshotel Velden.



Day 5 – Monday, 23rd April 2018: CARINTHIA

On Monday, we will visit Ebene Reichenau. Here, black Pinzgauer are bred on the Gleissner farm.



After a Carinthian ploughman's at the cheese dairy in Radenthein, we will explore Lake Wörthersee by boat.

Day 6 – Tuesday, 24th April 2018: CARINTHIA & SALZBURG

After visiting the Agricultural School Litzlhof near Spittal an der Drau, we will travel to Salzburg. We will visit a farm with Pinzgauer dairy cattle. Afterwards we will check in at Goldegg castle. In the evening, the directors of the IPCBA will hold a meeting.



Day 7 – Wednesday, 25th April 2018: SALZBURG

On Wednesday, we will visit the city of Salzburg. We will explore the historic city centre and will be officially welcomed in the Salzburg Residenz by representatives of the federal state of Salzburg. In the afternoon, we will go to Gastagwirt, a traditional inn with Pinzgauer steer fattening.



Day 8 – Thursday, 26th April 2018: SALZBURG

The XII. Pinzgauer World Congress will take place in Goldegg Castle. Internationally renowned scientists and experts will report on their research and present their results



Day 9 – Friday, 27th April 2018: SALZBURG

In the morning, we will visit the Agricultural School in Bruck. In the afternoon, we will go up Kitzsteinhorn mountain (3000 m), or, in bad weather, to the Hohe Tauern national park centre in Mittersill. We will end the day in the Weitmoserschlössl restaurant in Bad Hofgastein.



Day 10 – Saturday, 28th April 2018: SALZBURG

On Saturday, the focus is on Pinzgauer beef cattle breeding farms. Two farms will show us how they breed their Pinzgauer. In the evening, we will visit the Pinzgauer Young Breeders' Show in Maishofen.



Day 11 – Sunday, 29th April 2018: SALZBURG

Our journey ends with a visit to the Pinzgauer Cattle Show in Maishofen. Pinzgauer breeders will present their best animals from several European countries. In the evening, there will be a goodbye dinner.

Day 12 – Monday, 30th April 2018: SALZBURG
