

APA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

The American Pinzgauer Association will award general scholarships to young women and men that are actively engaged in the Pinzgauer breed and who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in higher education. The number of scholarships is subject to change depending on fund availability. If there is not a qualified applicant, funds will be retained for later scholarship use. The guidelines and requirements are outlined below. **Application must be postmarked by May 1st.**

Applicant Qualifications

The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or must be enrolled in a junior college, four year college/university or other accredited institution of higher learning.

Applicant must currently be a Junior or Adult member of the American Pinzgauer Association.

Applicant cannot have reached their 25th birthday prior to January 1st of the year of the application.

Applicant must have been an active member of the American Pinzgauer Association for at least three years.

Applicant must provide proof of entry into college or university before actual payment can be made to the institution.

Applicant can only receive this scholarship once and must utilize funds within one year of receipt of scholarship.

Applicant must submit to Scholarship Committee:

*A complete scholarship application

*A copy of most current high school or college transcript

*Three letters of recommendation - one personal, one school, one cattle related. Please do not use recommendations from relatives.
